The Red River Communications College Scholarship program recognizes and encourages the academic achievements of the students within our service territory by helping defray the costs of furthering their education. Applicant's family must currently be receiving one of our two core services: broadband internet or home phone (landline). **APPLICATION ARE DUE FRIDAY, MARCH 13TH, 2026.**

CRITERIA TO APPLY:

- You must be a high school senior graduating in the spring of 2026.
- The parent or legal guardian of the applicant must have an active Red River Communications account in good standing, and subscribe to a core service (local landline phone or broadband/internet).
- · You must be a United States citizen.
- During the last three years of school, you must have maintained a grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- You must be accepted by an accredited two-year or four-year college or university, or vocational or technical school/program.
- When selecting the scholarship for which you are applying, please note that some scholarships may be specific to certain fields of study.
- You must complete and sign the application, plus a personal reference must be completed. Incomplete
 applications will not be considered.

SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE:Select all Red River Scholarship(s) for which you are applying. Students may select more than one scholarship, but Red River will award only one scholarship per student.

GENERAL MEMBERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP (\$1,000) – EIGHT \$1,000 scholarships awarded to students within the service territory of the cooperative. Parent/legal guardian of the applicant must be a member of Red River Rural Telephone Association (DBA Red River Communications).
GENERAL CUSTOMER SCHOLARSHIP (\$1,000) – ONE \$1,000 scholarship awarded to a student within our entire service territory.
VOCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP (\$1,000) – ONE \$1,000 scholarship award to students pursuing an associate degree, credit-bearing certificate, or an industry-recognized credential at a vocational or technical school, trade school, two-year community college, or state college.
TECHNICAL SCHOLARSHIP (\$1,000) – ONE \$1,000 scholarship award to a student interested in the fields of telecommunications and technology. Students pursuing an undergraduate degree in a STEM field such as telecommunications, computer science, information systems, network engineering, telecommunication engineering, broadcast engineering technology, information or data technology, or a related program are eligible.
AGRICULTURAL SCHOLARSHIP (\$1,000) – ONE \$1,000 scholarship award for a student who plans to continue their education in a field related to the agricultural industry. Students pursuing an undergraduate degree in agribusiness, agriculture, animal/veterinarian science, earth science, natural resources, horticulture, range science, or a related program are eligible.
